Purpose

The Minot Symphony Association provides volunteer and financial support to help the Minot Symphony Orchestra achieve its mission.

The Minot Symphony, a university and community orchestra, aims to enrich lives by providing opportunities for musicians and inspiration to patrons through education and the performance of diverse orchestral repertoire.

Board Member Responsibilities

- Responsibility includes but not limited to
 - a) advise on proposed plans, policies, and other matters referred to the Association by Board of Directors
 - b) participate in long range planning processes as delegated by the Board of Directors.

- Regular board meetings are held 6 times per year, alternating months starting in September typically on the third Tuesday of the month. Any member absent from three consecutive meetings of the Board of Directors, without explanation, shall be considered to have resigned.

- Members of the board are expected to make a contribution of at least \$25 annually. This does not include orchestra reps.

- As a board member you are an advocate for the symphony. You should help promote concerts and seek donors, sponsors, ad sales and grant opportunities.

- As a representative of the symphony, you are expected to handle yourself in a professional manor at all symphony related events including concerts and fundraisers.

- Help out with the Garden Tour and Great Tomato Festival.

- Non-musicians need to help with ticket sales as needed for at least 1 performance per season.

- Participate on a committee at least once per year.
